What is Pharmacy First?

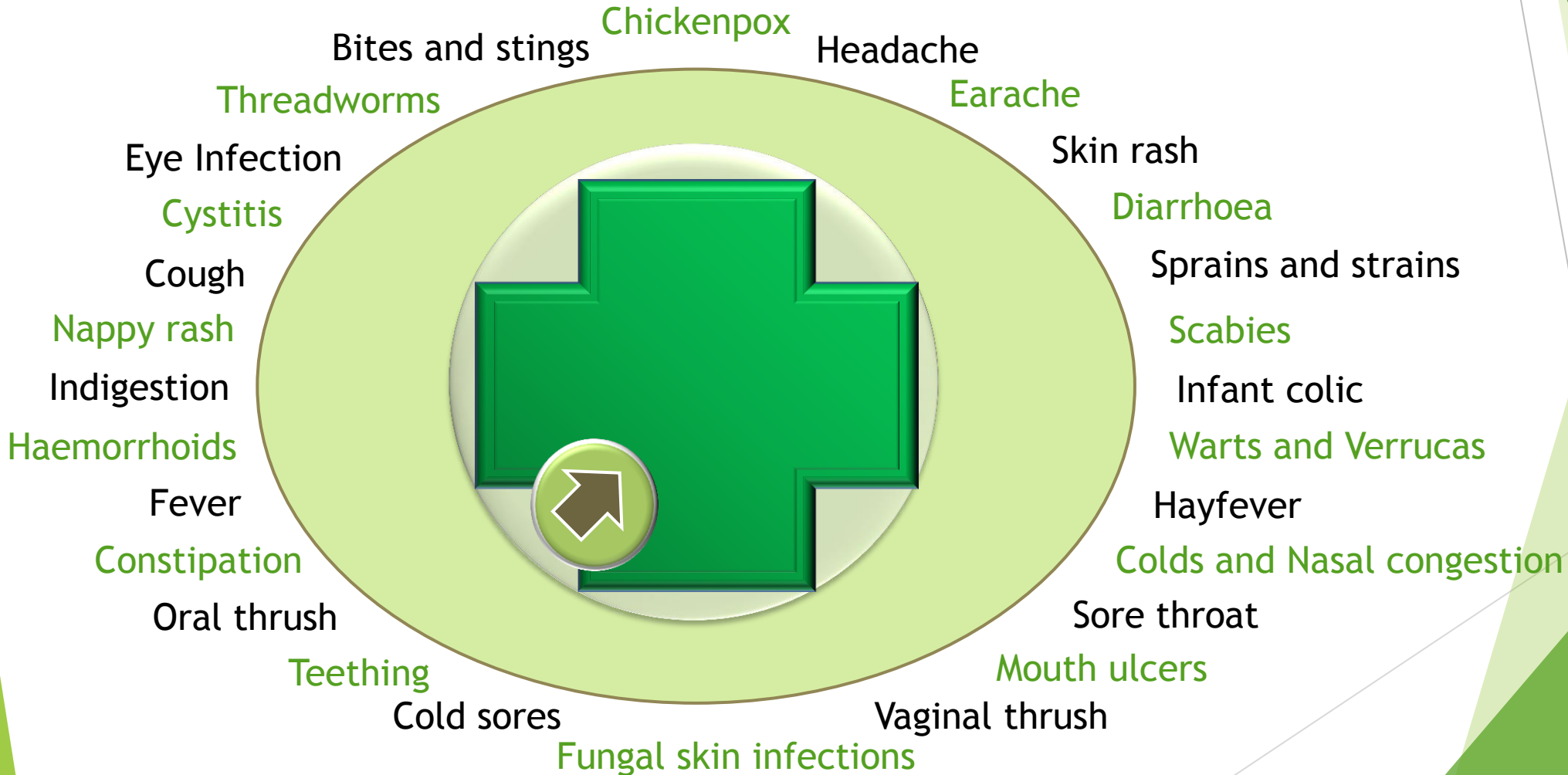
Pharmacy First is a scheme that is available for children and people who don't have to pay for their prescriptions and are suffering from a common ailment.

You can get advice and treatment for a range of common ailments **FREE OF CHARGE** from a participating pharmacy and no appointment is necessary



What conditions are included?

There are 28 different conditions included in the scheme



How do I access the service?

There are several ways to access the service including;

- self-referral at the pharmacy
- referral from your GP practice
- referral from Out of Hours Service or 111



What do I need to take to the pharmacy?

You will need to take the following information with you;

- confirmation of registration with your GP practice
- evidence of exemption from prescription charges
- your NHS number if known
